# REPORTS FROM MANAGEMENT:

# FINANCE & HR MANAGER:

VanDyke thanked the board for sending himself and Austin MacDougall to the 2024 CRA Finance & Human Resources Conference which offers valuable information and training on current and upcoming regulations and practices.

There are a few outstanding items to work through on the 2024 Financial Statements Audit which should be wrapped up in this coming week.

#### MANAGER:

CRASIF has their annual nominations request out.

Miscellaneous real estate offers keep arriving for various parcels at a value so low they would never warrant consideration.

The USFS has awarded an additional \$50,000.00 to our maintenance contract, stating that they appreciate the working relationship that we have had.

There is a MDOT bid opening set for June 6, 2024, to award work for shoulder paving on US-10 near Shepherd Road.

There is a gravel source near Leroy, MI which will work nicely for road improvements in the Olga Lake area and reduce the distance for trucking.

Pursuing a gravel source in White Cloud for road improvements in the southern portion of the county.

Guardrail has been installed on the Velt Road remediation project.
