LAKE COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

POLICY # 1002: POLITICAL/TEMPORARY SIGNS

STATEMENT OF POLICY:

Political/Temporary signs will be allowed on county roads as defined in this policy. Signs must not interfere with traffic, cause a hazard to traffic, or hinder any areas maintained for clear vision. Permission must be obtained from all property owners prior to the installation of any signs in the county right-of-way.

Signs that are 18"x24" or smaller placed in the county right-of-way must be placed at least 10' behind the white line or edge of the road. Signs and/or banners that are larger than 18"x24" must be placed at least 20' behind the white line or edge of the road.

In areas of platted subdivisions where the platted road is less than 66', signs must be placed outside of the platted road.

Non-conforming signs that are removed by the Road Commission will be disposed of every Tuesday after set pick up time. The set pick up time is from 2pm to 3pm. The political candidate with their name listed on the sign is the only individual that is allowed to pick up their signs and must check in with front office before doing so.

Signs must be removed from the right-of-way within 10 days after elections, it is the responsibility of each political candidate and party to remove their signs.

SIGNS OF ANY NATURE ARE NOT PERMITTED ON ANY ROAD COMMISSION OWNED PROPERTY.

ANY SIGNS THAT ARE FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION WILL BE DISPOSED OF AFTER SET PICK UP TIME ON TUESDAY'S.
