**COMMERCIAL DRIVEWAY
REQUIREMENTS - POLICY # 1021**

PERMANENT

The applicant will follow the MDOT specifications.

TEMPORARY

DEFINITION:

All driveways used for the purpose of exiting or entering the roadway while hauling any kind of cement, metal, or wood products. This could be a new or an existing driveway.

LOCATION:

The drive shall be located in the safest area possible while using our clear vision guideline sight distance chart. In the absence of a posted regulatory speed limit, 450 ft. of sight distance is required.

DESIGN FEATURES:

The Temporary Drive will have a minimum of 6 inches in depth of 22-A or 23-A State Specification gravel next to the roadway and at least 20 feet wide and 50 feet long, this will prevent mud tracking into the roadway, as required by the D.E.Q.

DRAINAGE REQUIREMENTS:

The Road Commission shall determine the length, size, and whether or not a culvert is required. The applicant shall furnish, install, maintain and remove the culvert upon completion of the job. Also, when the job is completed the ditch and shoulder will be replaced back to the original form. Upon failure to reestablish the ditch & shoulder back to the original form, the Road Commission will perform the work necessary and charge the applicant for the cost of labor and materials.

COST:

There is a \$50.00 charge for a Commercial Drive Permit.

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
